- Optical Sights in Pro Stock divisions, "1 only" means you may only have 1 optic mounted on the rifle, magnifiers if they use a separate mount count as another "optic" so are disallowed in the pro stock division. If the magnifier ATTACHES to the optic and does not require a separate mount then they would be allowed.
- Division Magazine capacities are listed as maximums allowable and subject to Canadian firearms law. Beowolf mags may be used in Stock/Pro-Stock as long as division capacity is not exceeded.
- Open division capacities are only limited by law and allow for full use of Beowolf magazines, or 9mm in a .40 mag as well.
- Pistol Caliber carbines are not allowed to be used, a carbine should be .223 rifle caliber or larger, if you choose to shoot pistol caliber carbines your shooting for fun.
- Breaching chokes are allowed. Brakes and Compensating chokes are disallowed in all divisions EXCEPT open class.
- Holsters, magazine pouches and shotgun pouches should all securely hold their items with moderate physical activity, it is one thing to drop a magazine on the ground but to have your pistol fall out of your holster would result in an immediate Disqualification of the competitor for unsafe firearms handling.
