**If you hunt in the Cherryville Area (MU 8-23) we need your assistance!**

*Monitoring is underway for both Bovine Tuberculosis (BTB) and Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD). Most of British Columbia is at low risk for both diseases, but **MU 8-23 is our focus for BTB.** There is no indication of wildlife infection so far but sampling has been limited.*

## **PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR DEER, ELK, AND MOOSE HEADS.**

### **HEADS SUBMITTED SHOULD BE:**

Freshly dead;

Not shot in the head; and

Ear tagged with the all of the correct information including kill location.

*The skull plate and antlers can be kept by the hunter.*
