All events will take place in good time irrespective of weather conditions. Any contestant withdrawing from or failing to start an event due to inclement weather will forfeit all entry fees, options and purses for that event.

### **Refunds**

No entry fees, options or purses will be refunded after an event has begun unless the competitor withdraws due to a genuine emergency. A broken gun is not an emergency

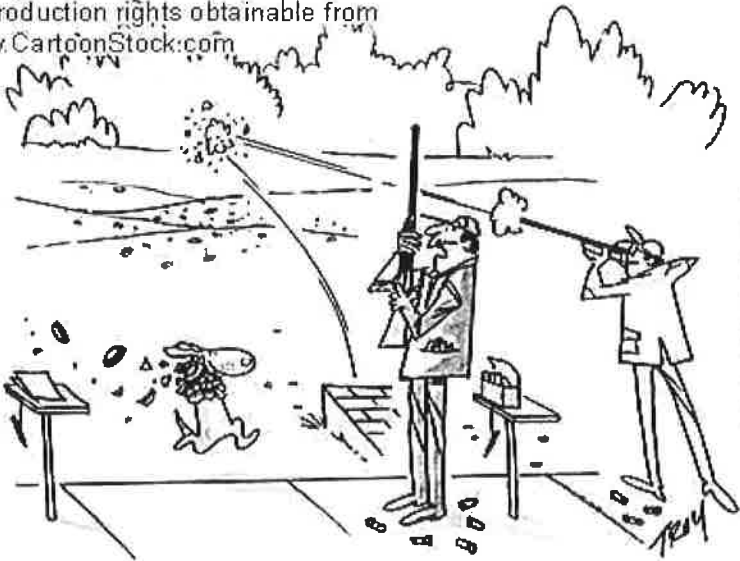

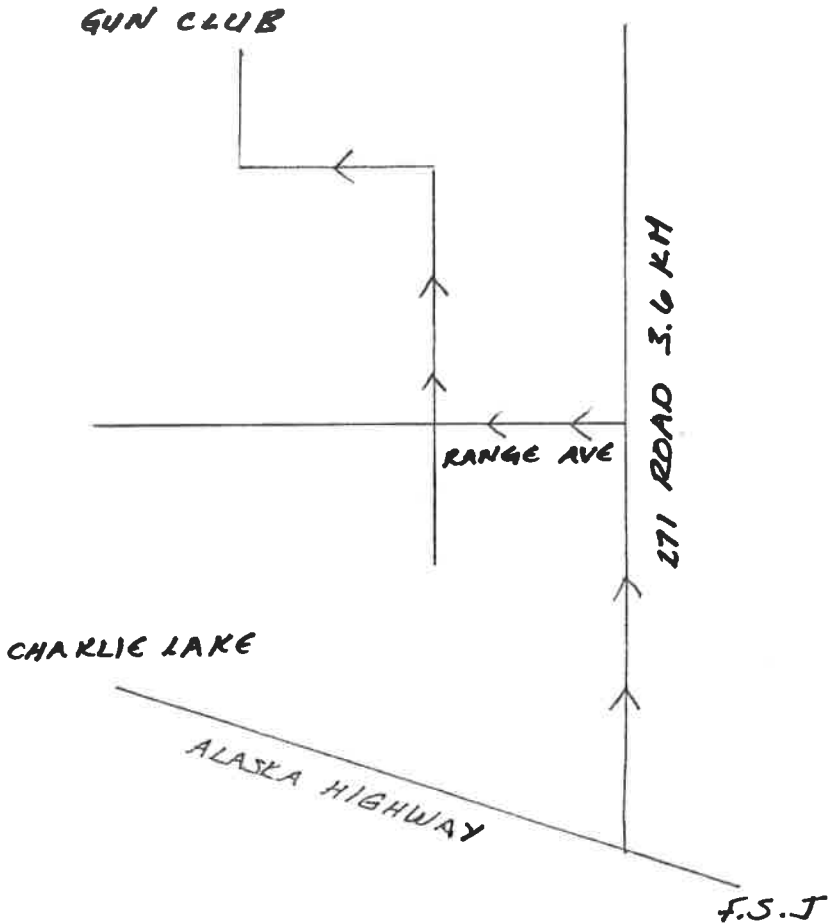

## **Rules**

This competition shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Pacific International Trapshooting Association

The Official Trap Shooting Rules state that all guns used by contestants must be so equipped and so used as not to eject shells in a manner to substantially disturb or interfere with other contestants. Please comply.

Please refrain from picking up empty shells from the ground. If you wish to keep them, save them.

## **Handicap Committee**

Each contestant must present himself/herself to the handicap committee for classification and handicapping. The committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter any time during the competition. All shooters participating in PITA registered competitions shall be classified not less than B class until they have registered 500 16 yd. targets. All shooters in PITA registered handicap competitions shall be assigned a 20 yard handicap yardage until they have registered 500 handicap targets.

## **Special Categories**

A Sub Junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. For events where no Sub-junior trophy is offered, Sub juniors shall be eligible to compete for the Junior trophy.

A Junior is a person who has attained their 15th birthday but has not attained their 18th birthday

A Veteran is a person who attained their 65th birthday but has not attained their 70th birthday

A Senior Veteran is a person who attained their 70th birthday but has not attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Senior Veteran trophy is offered, Senior Veterans shall be eligible to compete for the Veteran trophy

An Elder is a person who attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Elder trophy is offered, Elders shall be eligible to compete for the oldest category trophy available.
